R E S O L V E S,

First Article

The Permanent Latin America Committee for Crime Prevention (COPLAD) is established and made up of Experts, from nineteen Latin American Countries, with notable knowledge and dedication in favor of a more worth future of humanity.

Second Article

The role of the Permanent Latin America Committee for Crime Prevention (COPLAD) is to contribute to accountable practices related to comprehensive approaches of studies, research, assistance, training and exchange of experiences for implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals, Agenda 2030 of the United Nations, through criminal policies, social projects, education and global cooperation for the stability of the people of Latin America.
